As a faith-based community, we have always sought to serve as many people as possible, regardless of economic means. Our founding donors knew their seed donations would ultimately go to a Fellowship aid fund after the first generation of entry fees were collected. The first donations would then be used to help economically challenged people have access to the “power of living in community.”

The amount of charity we can do depends on the income we earn and the generosity of our donors. There are no other sources of charitable funds. We promise and deliver a lot:

- Lifetime hospitality service, and greater lifetime health care as needed.
- Lifetime financial dignity (financial peace of mind) for all who naturally outlive their savings.
- Our policy of admitting public and church servants with a greater than 50% chance of outliving their savings or who need Fellowship dollars from day one of their residency to meet our fees.
- 30% of apartments, the smaller ones, are priced below the cost of the lifetime services we provide.

**These four elements of resident charity cost \$2.6M per year.** We are proud of this amount of annual charity which we could never afford without our donors. This is just our charity services to our own residents at the Bay flagship campus. We also raise money to care better for our team and members and have dedicated funds to give us the “Edge of Excellence” in our services and campus.

Private Foundation support has been increasingly vital to more “Bringing Joy to Life” (the Foundation’s mission) for older adults. Enjoy our Annual Report and see the many ways we do this with your help.

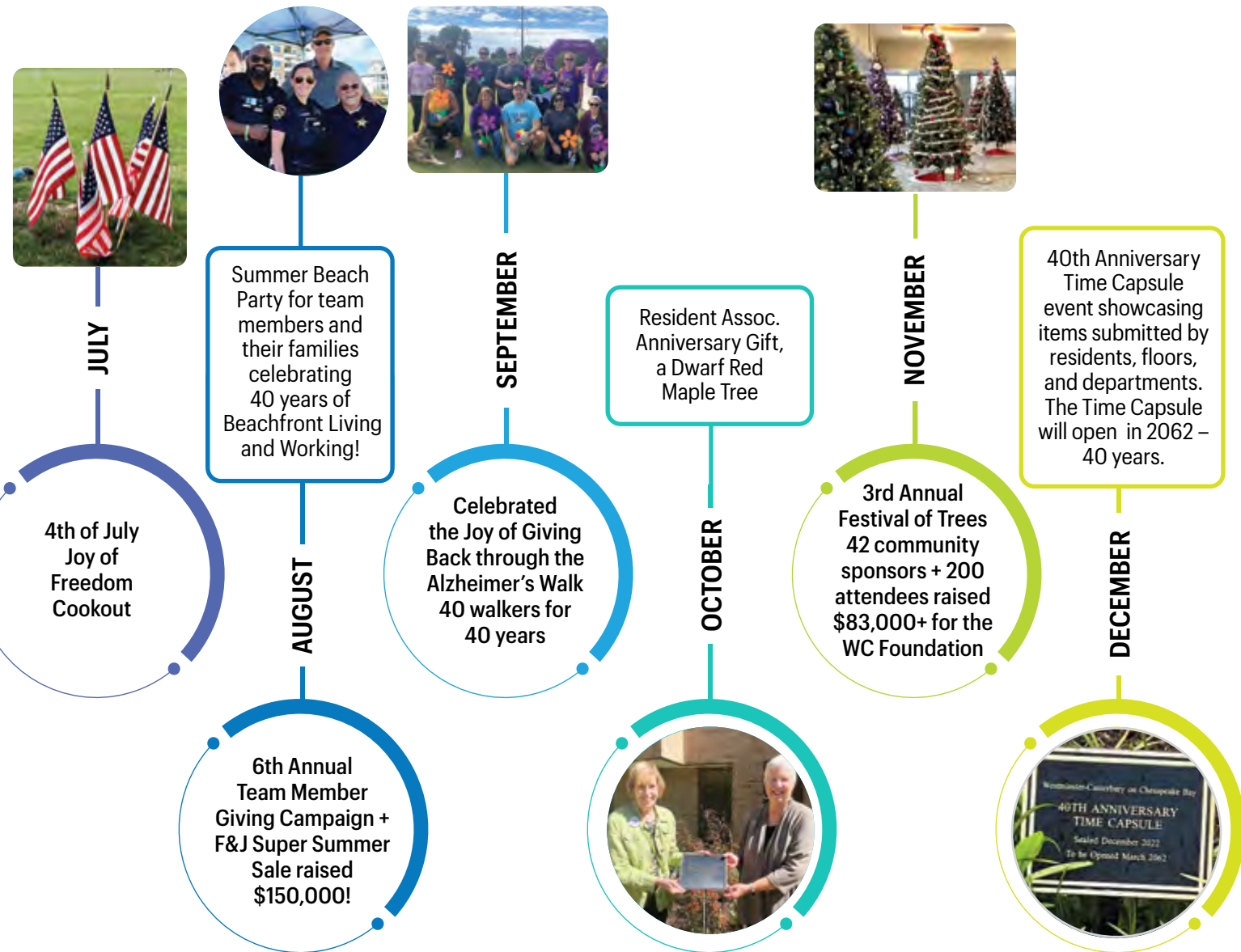

What a year! 2022 was the year of Joyful Living as we celebrated the 40th Anniversary of Westminster-Canterbury on Chesapeake Bay!

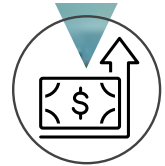

## How Does the Foundation Help?

The dream of our founders is that Westminster-Canterbury on Chesapeake Bay be an impactful and accessible community for seniors of every income level. Doing so requires more resources than those generated by mandatory fees. To realize the full economic accessibility, the founders started raising private money for our Fellowship Assistance Program even before enough gifts were secured to construct the East tower. Private community support is key to the commitment we have to serve older adults in Hampton Roads. Since it was created in 1992, the Foundation has led our fundraising efforts and programs.

Regardless of the designation, each dollar helps WC grow its mission's reach for the people it serves. Whether expanding amenities, sustaining current programs, or supporting new endeavors, charitable gifts reinforce that our simple service mission remains relevant in our complex world.

# Richard & Evelyn Keever

*discuss the importance of planned giving*

Richard and Evelyn Keever have always been people who give. They've given their time, talent, and abilities to help others throughout their lives. Dick gave 26 years of service as the Pastor of Bayside Presbyterian, in Virginia Beach, preaching, teaching, and providing counsel to those within the congregation and community. And as Chaplain at Children's Hospital of The King's Daughters, Evie, a United Methodist Minister, offered spiritual care to countless patients, families, and staff.

And their generosity has gone beyond their occupations serving the wider community, such as the Ronald McDonald House Board, and through Hospice in Virginia Beach. Dick has donated his time to Westminster-Canterbury on Chesapeake Bay in multiple areas, including as a board member, and board president. He also currently serves on the board of the WC Foundation. "Charitable giving has been a part of my life since I was a child," says Evie, who moved with Richard to our community, a little more than a year ago, after seeing the focused and personal attention her mother received in WC respite

care and later through their Hospice program.

And for the couple, who met at Yale Divinity School, two things made absolute sense. 1) their generosity in life would continue into their legacies through Planned Giving. And 2) they would make a Bequest for a Testamentary Gift to the WC Foundation.

As residents, they appreciate the location and activities WC offers. "I love the location and the bay and the views of the water," Evie says, "It's always changing and giving life to me." And Dick enjoys the Fitness Center but admits he may need to visit it more often. "When you eat these good meals," he laughs, "you need to keep physically fit, or at least try!"

But what draws them – and their support – to WC is the people. "I love the people, the other residents, and the staff. They're so caring and welcoming. They make it a happy place," Evie says, "People are always looking for joy in their lives, and WC certainly provides."

At its core, the WC Foundation is about people. "The Foundation serves a significant role in ensuring

that people – regardless of their ability to pay – can be attended to and be part of a community during this special time in their lives," says Evie. The Foundation also provides continuing education scholarships and emergency support for WC staff.

The strength of WC largely depends on the foresight and support of those who look to the future. This is why Dick suggested sending a letter to new residents encouraging them to consider updating their Wills to name the WC Foundation as a beneficiary. Dick says taking the time to consider this makes a statement about their priorities.

For the Keevers, whose planning includes supporting the Children's Hospital and educational institutions as well as WC, giving for them is lifelong.

"With a planned gift, you know your life will live on," says Dick.

"I really like the idea that we are supporting the ongoing full spectrum of life," Evie agrees, "that is why planned giving is so crucial."

Dick likes to remind folks of this well-known observation: "*You make a living by what you receive. You make a life by what you give.*"

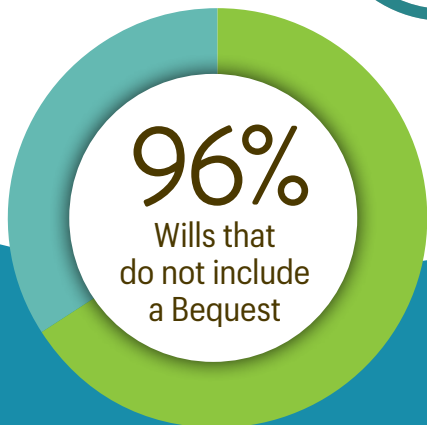
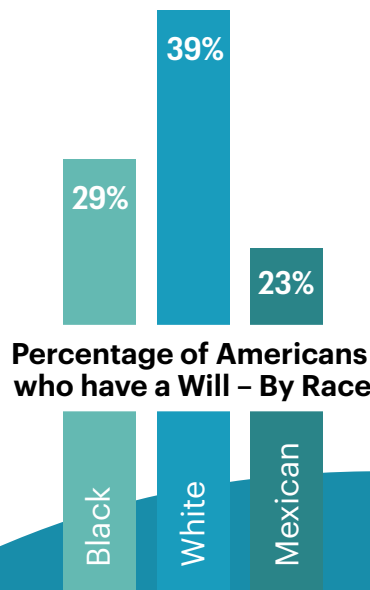
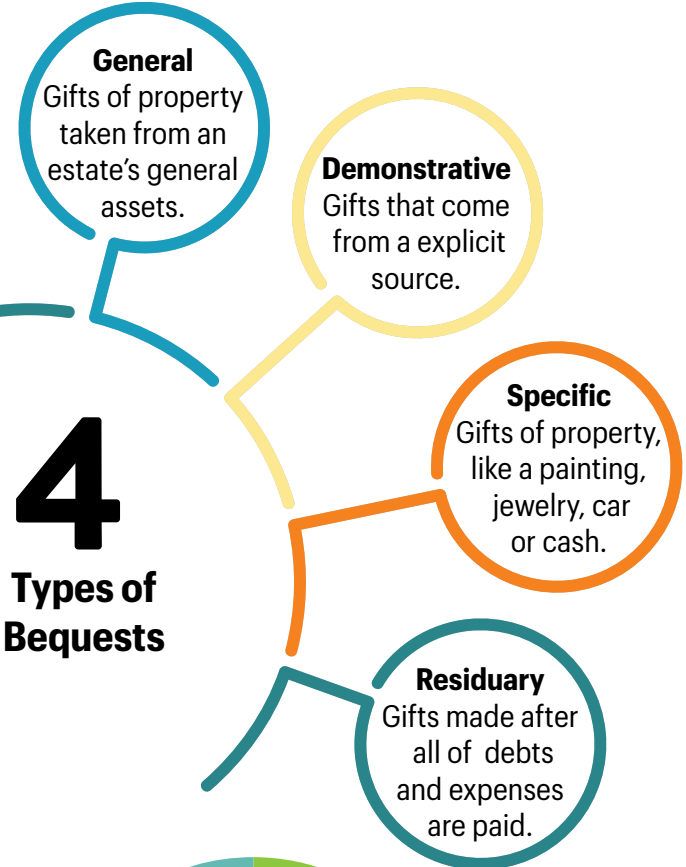

## Spot Light on a Work Hero

# Demetra Williams

BSN, RN, ADON/SDC

Demetra Williams remembers her first day at Westminster-Canterbury on the Chesapeake Bay. She was a new LPN, hired to start on the night shift. “I was nervous as can be. I was barely 21 and was terrified,” she remembers.

Seventeen years later, the intrinsically positive Demetra is Assistant Director of Nursing and Staff Development, and it’s safe to say that she’s found her place. Demetra was recently honored with the Distinguished Team Member Award. “The presentation blew me away,” she says, “All those photos and images of me brought back so many memories. I felt so appreciated for everything I’ve done here.”

And Demetra has done a lot. She serves as the Infection Prevention & Control Nurse, assists with process improvement, and coordinates new hire orientation and ongoing clinical education. She was also vital in implementing several new initiatives to ease workflow and improve resident safety.

In her time at WC, Demetra advanced her clinical skills and developed her leadership style. “[At WC], I was able to learn from those who served as mentors to me,” she says, “And I was inspired to go back to school. I got my BSN and became an RN.”

Demetra enhances all that is around her. “[Demetra’s] depth of institutional knowledge is key in the implementation of new and updated practices,” says Lydia Anderson, Director of Nursing, “She balances

all of this with grace, compassion, and kindness, which improves the overall team morale. She is a gift of a human and a leader.”

Demetra lives the WC Mission, to create a community to foster joy and well-being. “To me, joy is what we do. It’s our main goal regarding the residents and what we’re providing. We want them to have a joyous experience every day by giving them happiness and improving and promoting their quality of life. [Our mission] gives me purpose,” she pauses, “That’s important.”

One of the ways that she brings joy through her work at WC is through her engagement with residents, families, and staff. Before the pandemic, a holiday tradition was to decorate each floor with a different theme. This is one of Demetra’s fondest memories because of the inclusion. “Everyone played a part in decorating, and there was so much joy and happiness around it,” she says. She thrives in helping to create those positive memories for all involved.

It’s evident to her colleagues that Demetra’s dedication to the Hoy Center and WC is deeply rooted in her values, as is her desire to learn and grow as a leader continuously, says Alex Hill, Campus Director of Quality. Demetra can’t imagine doing this anywhere else. “This is a second family for me. It’s the culture. My teammates, the residents, the families. Mentors and my supervisor. When I wake up in the morning, I enjoy coming to work. I’m happy to be here.”

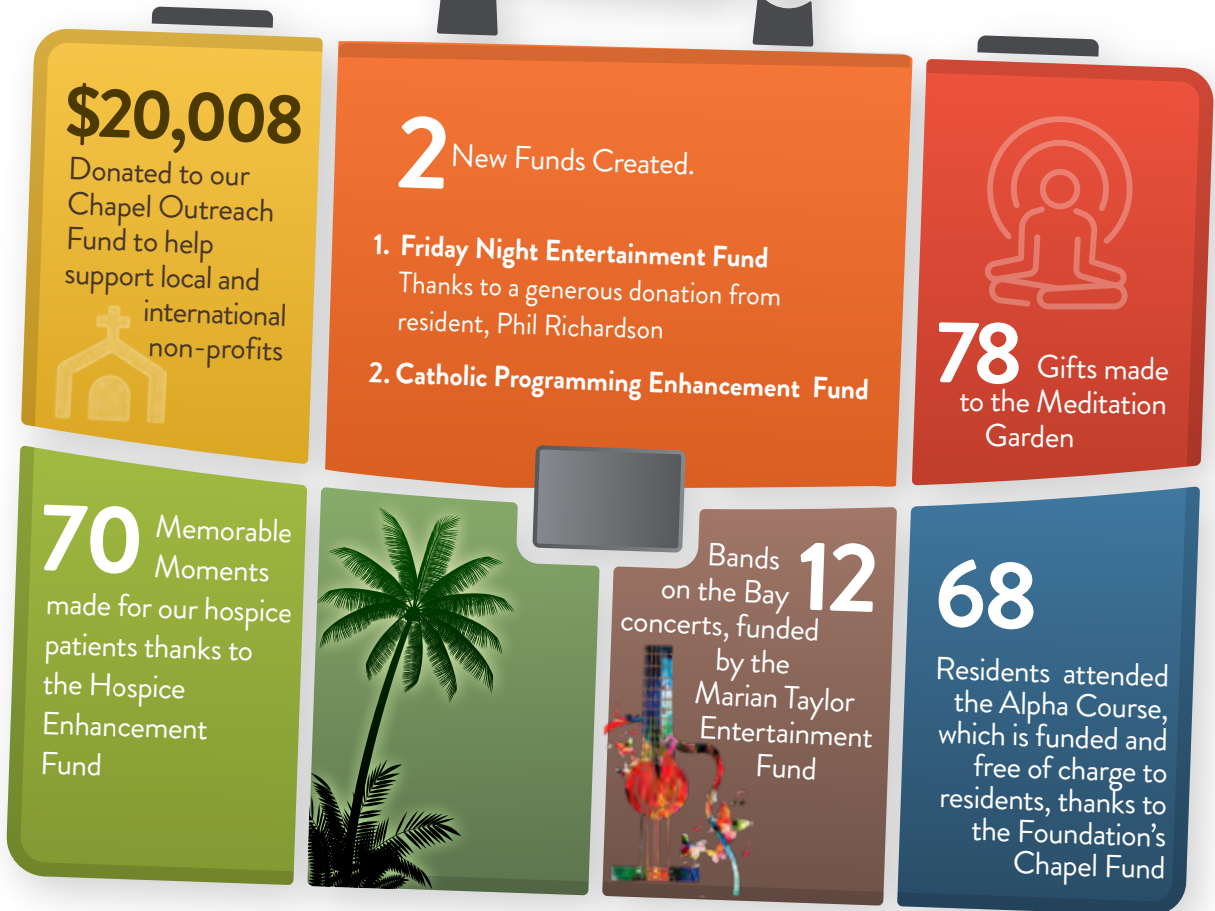
